

## <u>Treating efflorescence and salts for adhesion of Maxseal</u> <u>Flex, FLEX ''M'', FOUNDATION to a masonry block substrate</u>

Products required

- EFFLORESCENCE RID
- BLOCKSEALT ULTRA
- MAXSEAL FLEX, MAXSEALFLEX "M", FOUNDATION.

## Method

- 1. Prepare area to be treated by removing any loose materials and existing salt deposits ensuring a clean and sound porous surface (pressure water blasting prior to application is NOT recommended as this will bring more salt to surface).
- 2. Apply Efflorescence Rid wait for foaming to stop, remove by washing and reapply until all foaming stops.
- 3. Allow surface to dry before application of Blockseal Ultra
- 4. Apply MAXSEAL FLEX, ETC. while wet with BLOCKSEAL
- 5. Allow MAXSEAL FLEX, ETC. to cure overnight...
- 6. Apply another coat of MAXSEAL FLEX, ETC. minimum 14 hours as specified by technical data bulletin # 29.05
