TREATING EFFLORESCENCE IN GROUT LINES

Efflorescence through grout on tiled balconies.

We recommend the following: -



a. Remove all loose material and efflorescence as well as cleaning out missing grout areas – apply Efflorescence Rid using Efflorescence-rid sprayed via a low-pressure sprayer.



- b. Remove all loose & damaged grout, allow area to dry completely
- c. Repeat the application of Efflorescence rid until foaming stops which may require more than 3 passes depending on the amount of efflorescence present.
- d. On completion of last pass with Efflorescence-Rid wash area with clean water. Allow area to dry completely.
- e. Using a "squeeze bottle" pour Sealtight into grout lines and screed where tile grout
 - has been removed, to the point of flooding the screed.
- f. Allow the Sealtight to dry over a min of 24 hours.
- g. Re-apply tile grout and allow to dry.
- h. Once tile grout is dry, saturate all the <u>tile grout</u> within the entire balcony with Sealtight. Ensure that Sealtight has a min of 24 hours to dry before getting wet.
